#### Thought for the Month - Rev Anthony Smith

How long have you lived round here? In my case, as I write this at the end of July, the answer is: 11 days! My wife and I have just moved from Spennymoor to Middleton St George, for me to be the new priest in charge (vicar) of the Riverside Parishes. By the time you read this, I will have officially been 'licensed', and will have well and truly begun.

## **Q&A with Revd Anthony Smith**

People from the Riverside Parishes submitted some questions to Anthony.

#### Have you always lived around here?

Only since 2016. I grew up in Hitchin, Hertfordshire, but my parents are from Middlesbrough and Hull, so I've always felt at home in the North East.

#### Have you always been a vicar?

This is my first job as a proper vicar! I've just spent four years in Spennymoor as a curate (assistant vicar), after three years training in Durham.

I've been going to church since I was born, but by the time I was ten I had decided it was all a load of rubbish. But God seemed to have other plans, and I've been an enthusiastic Christian since I was 15. Becoming a vicar hasn't been a complete surprise, but I took the scenic route!

#### What did you do before becoming a vicar?

Music was a big thing in my younger days, mainly singing in choirs and playing the organ and piano. I love all kinds of music in church, and I still do plenty of music outside of church.

Astronomy kept me busy in my twenties. I never had a telescope, but I was into science, and I spent a few years counting galaxies at Sussex University (Brighton), exploring the vastness of God's creation with the help of a computer and some big telescopes in Hawaii and in space. (Hawaii is wonderful, by the way, but I haven't been into space!)

Computer software is the third thing I've done. It doesn't sound as exciting as music or astronomy, but I enjoyed it! It forces you to think clearly and express yourself clearly, which is useful for a vicar. I drifted into software from astronomy, and it kept me going for a few years, after I moved to York to get married to Eline, and then to Merseyside for Eline's work.

#### What do you like most about the ministry?

I believe that through Jesus Christ we can know God personally. I love helping people to know God better, whether they are exploring Christianity for the first time, or responding to God in new ways.

# What food do you hope to find at the banquet table in the kingdom of God, and what music would you like to accompany the feasting and celebrations?

I would love a good curry, with all sorts of herbs and spices from God's good creation, and for the music some energetic dances by Bach or Monteverdi would be ideal!

#### What would your ideal day off look like?

Time outdoors, probably at the seaside, followed by a meal out and a concert, or a takeaway in front of a good film.

#### Why did you want to come to the Riverside Parishes?

There's a lot of life in the churches, and a real sense of excitement about what God is doing. We were keen to stay in the region for Eline's work, and it's a beautiful area too!



#### All Done With Sophistication

The book NAIRN'S COUNTY DURHAM was derived from an article written by Ian Nairn for The Architectural Review Feb 1964 after visiting 76 Co Durham towns and villages, reprinted 2015. In that publication Nairn wrote with great enthusiasm about his likes and dislikes, one of the former being our very own Hurworth which he describes as follows:

"If there are southern gentlemen who think that anything north of Barnet is a bit crude and bleak, they ought to take a look at this."

"Hurworth is three miles from Darlington and it must always have been a special village. The long green is lined with every kind of style and size of architecture from the last two centuries: but all is done with sophistication - never needing to raise its voice, bound at a deeper level than conformity, all epicures together. At the west end the village begins with the puzzle of a single gatepost, apparently eighteenth-century, which turns out to be a coronation memorial to George V. Hurworth is that sort of place. At the east end, the churchyard wall has been lowered to give a discreet, Augustan view over the Tees, fifty feet below. And all of this savoir-faire is innate: none of it is done at you, like Chelsea or Hampstead."

We could not have put it better.


